- All crews to listen and act quickly to marshal's orders.
- The marshalling area is from above the start to Mapledurham lock.
- THERE WILL BE NO FIRM PADDLING OR PRACTICE STARTS IN THE MARSHALLING AREA
- Crews 1 17 face upstream on Berks bank by the wall
- Crews 18 34 face upstream on Berks bank on outside of bend to Marina.
- Crews 35 78 face upstream on the Oxfordshire bank with 35 at the downstream end.
- Tops should be removed **before** turning so that once turned, the crews are ready to race.
- Crews will turn in order from the downstream end of the line.
- Once turned, crews to paddle light towards the start close to the Berkshire bank maintaining a distance of **4 5 lengths** between each other.
- Crews will be started at **20-30 second intervals** to avoid overtaking at the first island.
- Crews too close to the crew in front will be stopped by a marshal or the starter
- Crews late to the marshalling area (after 10:15) will be held back and will start at the end of the division and may incur a time penalty for being late to the start.

- Crews 201 221 face upstream on Berks Bank by the wall
- Crews 222 229face upstream on Berks Bank on outside of bend to Marina
- Crews 230 265 face upstream on the Oxfordshire bank with 230 at the downstream end.
- Tops should be removed **before** turning so that once turned, the crews are ready to
- Crews will turn in order from the downstream end of the line.
- Once turned, crews to paddle light towards the start close to the Berkshire bank maintaining a distance of 4 – 5 lengths between each other.
- Crews will be started at **20-30 second intervals** to avoid overtaking at the first island.
- Crews too close to the crew in front will be stopped by a marshal or the starter
- Crews late to the marshalling area (after 2:15) will be held back and will start at the end of the division and may incur a time penalty for being late to the start.
